

Instructions for Ordering Certified FINOLA Planting Seed and the 2020 Price List

Order your seed through this link <http://finola.fi/order-finola/>

All of our planting seed is officially certified, and each bag has its own certification tag. This tag may not be legally copied or used to resell smaller amounts of seed from the original bag. This is an international regulation, not our opinion. Also, we are not sending seed outside of the Euro zone in 2020.

For industrial scale hempseed grain production, we suggest a seeding rate between 25-30 kg/ha. First time growers should sow at least 30 kg/ha for best results. Good soil conditions, correct sowing depth, sufficient fertilisation and moisture are essential for this crop to produce good results. New for 2020- 2.5 kg bags of certified FINOLA planting seed!

The 2.5 kg bag contains about 20 000 FINOLA seeds (half male and half female). The price for one bag is €75, plus €40 for UPS delivery in Europe. These small bags will be invoiced and distributed from Germany.

For orders less than 5 x 25 kg (125 kg), each bag is sent separately by UPS from our partner in Germany, by Bafa neu GmbH, at a cost of €40 per 25 kg bag.

Larger orders are sent on EUR wooden pallets. This is more economical, and the delivery cost is determined by the weight and delivery address. Orders that are over 20 x 25 kg (500 kg) may be sent to you from Finland. We can load up to 750 kg (30 x 25 kg bags) on one EUR pallet. This our most economical unit.

All prices are without the value added tax (VAT). We will add 14% for European customers who do not have a valid VAT number.

After placing your order, will send you an invoice that includes the full costs of the seed and door to door transport. To save on transport costs, most orders less than 20 x 25 kg (500 kg) will be distributed by our partner, Bafa neu GmbH.

All payments must be received before we send your seed. We only accept payments by direct bank transfer. We do not accept credit cards or cryptocurrencies. Please, do not send partial payments!

Current status of FINOLA in the European Union

FINOLA continues to remain on the official list of approved hemp varieties in Europe, and European farmers are entitled to the Single Payment (CAP) subsidy for the cultivation of FINOLA in all EU Member States. If official field samples are still collected for THC testing in your country, please be sure to help your agricultural officials plan for the correct time to collect FINOLA field samples; about 55 days after sowing. The correct sampling time typically begins about 45 days after sowing for this fast maturing variety, and even sooner in hot or dry climates. Also, please inform us if late samples are collected from your field.
